Just a note to keep you abreast as to what has happened over the winter. On February 6th, 2010, we held an advisory board meeting and drew up a tentative schedule for our entire summer, (See page 2). We did not, however, come up with a spring or fall get-away destination. If any of you have a ride you wish to submit to us, we will be more than happy to discuss it. We have an interest from other clubs to join us in this ride so here is a chance to get to meet new people with new ideas.

For those of you who are trail patrol people, this is our year to keep those yellow vests active. This year, we will be doing this in conjunction with the Wolf River Riders ATV club. The dates will be Saturday, May 29th and Sunday, May 30th from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon both days. The class will be held in Pickerel, WI. If you have any questions, please contact Pat Girtz at 715-484-3634. She will be glad to answer them.

The WATVA (Wisconsin ATV Assoc.) annual meeting was held at the Plaza Hotel in Wausau on April 16 - 18th. The Highlanders set up a club display this year and several members attended some of the very informational workshops. One of the issues covered was club liability – so take note that our renewal form now has a disclaimer on the back side. Recreational Safety Warden, Jon King and Bureau of Law Enforcement ATV Administrator, Gary Eddy gave a presentation/

role playing on Trail Patrol and reminded people that trail patrolers do not have the authority to detain riders on the trails. If you see an infraction in progress, take down the riders registration number and report it to the local DNR office and better yet, carry a camera. The group was also informed that all trail patrolers will soon be receiving notification that besides helping with a safety training every two years, they will need to take a “refresher” test that will be good for three years. The test is already available on the DNR website in the Volunteer Safety Instructor Forms. There were also presentations on the statewide Wisconsin UTV program, the possibility of selected road route (Trout) funding, wetland identification and trail interfaces, and the Wisconsin ATV Trails Report.

Our first meeting for the year is fast approaching and we hope to see a lot more of our members attending this year. We always have some great raffle items at our meetings so don't miss out on the fun and remember, the meetings are now the 2nd Saturday of the month instead of the 1st. This was changed to avoid any trail opening delays and holiday conflicts.

Also, it's that time of year again to renew your membership. Starting this year we have streamlined the form and will no longer have a separate family and single membership rate. Instead it will just be a flat \$15.
