On a serious note, I have gotten complaints of ATVs running down Parrish Road (from Hwy. 17 to Hwy. H) at a high rate of speed. The speed limit there is only 10 M.P.H. because of the houses on each side of the road. These home owners are warning us that they are thinking of going to the town board and will be asking to close this route if we don't **SLOW DOWN**.

Now I realize that a great deal of these speeders don't even belong to our club but we must do everything we can to stop those who are not obeying the speed limit. If we lose this route, we won't have access to the Parrish Cafe and we won't be able to cross Hwy. 17 into the Harrison trails. Also, we must try to control the ATV riders from riding on Hwy. H from Fisher's Bar to the top of the hill (to Five Cent Road). We will be talking about this at our July 12th meeting. A lot of us have the yellow trail patrol vests. I think it is time we started using them.

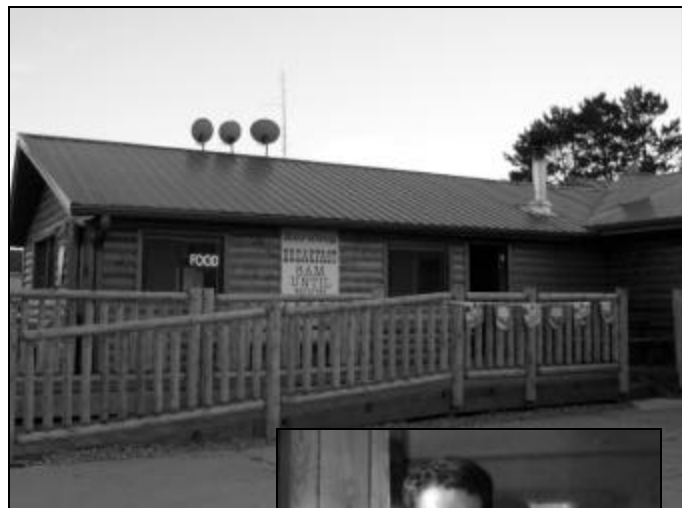
